Sanct Valentin Gewürztraminer has an intense and complex bouquet, with aromas reminiscent of Asian spices, the delicate scent of roses and exotic fruits. As early as 1986, Gewürztraminer was vinified for the first time as the top growth of the Sanct Valentin line. It is set apart for its longevity, which promises a wonderful drinking experience even after many years.

VARIETY:

Gewürztraminer

AGE:

5-35 years

AREA OF CULTIVATION:

Sites: Selected vineyards in Appiano and Caldaro (300-500m)

Exposure: Southeast

Soil: Loamy limestone gravel

Training System: Guyot

HARVEST:

Mid of September; harvest and selection of grapes by hand.

VINIFICATION:

Maceration of the grapes followed by gentle pressing. Fermentation and development in stainless-steel tanks.

YIELD:

45 hl/ha

Alcoholic Content: 14%

Residual Sugar: 6,0 gr/ltr

Acidity: 4,40 gr/ltr

SERVING TEMPERATURE:

8-10° C
